## GOD, SEX, AND PSYCHOSIS

A relevant and a compelling story, *God, Sex & Psychosis* explores the psychological damage that occurs after sexual abuse and rape, to children, both male and female.


The subject is timely considering current events with the MeToo movement, sexual assault allegations, and the Senate's Brett Kavanaugh Supreme Court Judicial hearings. Key topics are dissociative identity disorder, rape, incest, teenage violence, and college date rape. The underlying theme: how do individuals, especially children, cope with sexual trauma throughout their lives? What is the mental and spiritual path to recovery, to revenge, to love, and to a restorative redemption?

*God, Sex & Psychosis* is, in essence, a psychological puzzle. The protagonists' experiences of sexual trauma at an early age affected them in distinctively different ways: one becomes a criminal psychologist; the other, a performing artist. In their professional lives, both are intelligent and functional, yet they are dysfunctional in other areas. Part One highlights the formative years of Egon and his twin sister, Faye, both traumatized by an abusive father. Part Two illustrates the fragmented points of view of both siblings, now adults, undergoing analysis by Mira, a court-appointed psychotherapist struggling with her own inner demons. Part Three is Mira's story, a confessional of how she was gang-raped at age twelve and scarred by her attackers; how her rage manifested into a quest for revenge, which caused two deaths at the college she had attended; and how these incidents are all connected to the recent murders taking place in San Francisco.

A root cause of dissociative identity disorder is sexual trauma at an early age. And with this disorder, a person's identity is fragmented into two or more independent personalities.

Not only a suspenseful thriller, *God, Sex & Psychosis* is, at its core, a love story between two damaged souls struggling to overcome their afflictions. Infused with seemingly independent and irredeemable elements, these pieces combine to explain Egon's and Mira's attraction and improbable bond. And, no, they are not the same person. The conclusion is more complex and unexpected.
